Background information:

After undertaking an audit and talking with teachers it is clear that two of the main reasons for non-school participation in school sport events, inter-school competitions, festivals, fixtures, visits to international events/to meet international sports athletes/champions have been:

- the high cost of and lack of school transport and – the cost of teacher release/cover to accompany pupils, to off site school sport events.

The Howard School Sport Partnership is keen to encourage schools to attend these events to help inspire young people to take up new sporting activities, to help keep up their motivation to be physically active for life and learn first hand about team work, competing against their peers and how a large scale event is organised.

School budgets and priorities vary and the Howard School Sports Partnership wishes to encourage and enable other schools in the partnership to participate in these school sport events, through this small grant programme. The Howard School Sport Partnership only has a very small budget set aside for this programme per year and not enough for all 59 School's. Please consider working with other schools when applying i.e. sharing transportation, particularly if attending the same event.

The maximum grant per school per application will be £150. The maximum number of successful applications per school per academic year will be 2, with a maximum grant of £300 per academic year from this fund.
