In order to achieve the full certificate candidates must complete Modules 1 and 2 (Units 1 - 5). Candidates who complete module 1 only (units 1 and 2) will receive an attendance certificate. The qualification is designed to be delivered using a combination of theory and practical throughout both modules. Module 1 (i.e. Units 1 and 2) must be completed prior to progressing onto Module 2 (Units 3 - 5). Units 3 - 5 can be completed in any order. The Certificate for Teaching School Swimming (Key stages 1 and 2) is open to any person working within a primary school swimming programme, e.g. school teacher, classroom assistant, learning support staff, nursery nurse, qualified swimming teachers, parent, other helpers etc. In addition, students involved in initial teacher training may also attend.

Module 1

Once qualified, the holder of the ASA/NCTP Module 1 (School Swimming - Key Stages 1 and 2) will be equipped to actively assist and/or support a more qualified teacher in the teaching of a range of core aquatic skills to a small group of similar ability within the context of a school swimming programme.

Assessment for Module 1 Units 1/2 is by attendance of the full six hours, and it is therefore essential that the full three-hour per unit timetabled sessions are attended. One or more of the pool sessions will include activities in water, so please bring swimwear, towel(s), etc. This is a valuable session and will be tailored to suit both strong swimmers and less able ones or those lacking in water confidence. .

Module 2

Once qualified the holder of the ASA/NCTP Modules 1 and 2 (School Swimming - Key Stages 1 and 2) will be equipped with the skills to plan and evaluate a programme designed to meet the swimming component of the National Curriculum (NC) and to teach without supervision, a range of skills to groups within a school swimming programme.

Assessment for Module 2 Units 3, 4 and 5 is by both attendance and successful completion of practical activities, and it is therefore essential that the full three-hour per unit timetabled sessions are attended. Pool sessions may include activities in the water, so please bring swimwear and towel, etc.

Equipment and clothing

Poolside clothing for the teaching session(s) should be appropriate: shorts/leggings/lightweight tracksuit bottoms and T shirts/polo shirts with discreet logos. Footwear must be worn poolside and should be pool-type sandals or trainers that must clean and not worn outside - an essential requirement for hygiene purposes. Also, do please remember to bring a clipboard and note-taking materials with you, as well as any course materials you might already have received during Module 1 such as the ASA NCTP Learner Guide and TOP Swim cards.
