**BASELINE MEMBERSHIP: SSP BENEFITS PACKAGE (Baseline services minimum £500 per school for the whole year)**

<p><b>1. GENERAL CENTRAL SUPPORT</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Health and safety advice from a Secondary P.E qualified Teacher (SSCo) and access to occasional cluster/family/Partnership/Medway wide PLT meetings/networking /training sessions as and when required.</li> <li>- Organising where demand is high, occasional teacher/teaching assistant sports coach CPD/coach education courses for all to access (several twilights/weekday or weekends).</li> <li>- Access to central HSSP office (telephone, regular email updates for new projects/activities/sports opportunities for your pupils, newsletter and website support) throughout the academic year, including information on the Medway and HSSP inter-school sports event calendar.</li> <li>- Long term loan of sports equipment and some P.E. Teaching resources such as schemes of work (S.O.W.) from central HSSP office.</li> <li>- Free access to any central grants successfully secured or sponsored sports activities (through commercial sponsor or national governing body of sport/local community club), that the HSSP gains on your individual schools behalf, as part of a wider OSHL/sports project for a group of schools.</li> <li>- Information on how to find qualified screened sports coaches/sports volunteers through Medway Sports Coach register and Medway Event Volunteers register.</li> <li>- Advice and support on creating community club links with local clubmark sports clubs and coaches.</li> <li>- Advice on how schools can apply for their own grants and help on how to fund raise.</li> <li>- Assistance with transport where possible i.e. possible use of secondary school /other shared mini bus and driver if available and convenient to secondary school and Primary School sharing transport and staff.</li> </ul>	<p><b>2. SSCO CURRICULUM SUPPORT</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Access to SSCO/Trainer mentor support for 6 hours (one whole day) for initial planning and support to deliver – for PLT Action Plan (<a href="#">linked to School Improvement plan</a>) offering advice and support under 4 areas (PE Curr./OSHL and community links/Competition/and Leadership and Volunteering). - whole day of SSCO's time (could be spread over several weeks if required). This could include items such as:</li> <li>- CPD One Twilight training session (2hours max.) with whole school staff including hand outs</li> <li>- Five x 1.5 hour team teaching CPD sessions (one to one P.E. mentor support)</li> <li>- One twilight meeting with group of PLT's/T.A.'s giving advice/training and working together on joint project</li> <li>- Advice on Schemes of Work/Assessment – relevant topic</li> </ul>	<p><b>3a. AFTER-SCHOOL SPORTS CLUB SUPPORT</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Access to ONE qualified Sports Coach [sport/physical activity to be agreed – depending upon the availability of the Coach] (and possibly student sports leader/volunteer to assist) for a min. 4 weeks/max. 5 week term (one hour max. per week) for after-school/breakfast/lunchtime sports coaching (T.A./PLT/other teacher to attend to learn and use as CPD for their own training needs). FESTIVALS INTER –SCHOOL SPORT FESTIVALS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Entry into any 4 of the Howard SSP organised inter-school competitions/Festivals (not including Mini Youth Games- MYG) in academic year</li> <li>- Largely central venue participation Festivals with assistance from student sports leaders being organised by SSCO's and PDM. These are currently (mainly for yrs. 1-4 ,for example: Tri Golf Festival x 2 (yrs. 1-4), Multi-Skills Festival x 2 (K.S. 1 and 2), Key Step Gymnastics (Yrs 1-4), Sports Hall Athletics (yrs 5 and 6), Dance Festival (yrs 1-13), Racket Skills Festival (yrs 3 and 4) and other SSCO family/cluster led Festivals i.e. rounders/speed stacking/skipping etc).</li> </ul>

As well as visiting other community and secondary school sporting venues (possibly helping with transition) and being encouraged to participate in community clubs. **NOTE: The Howard SSP and staff will continue to search for external funding sources and sponsorship to pay for new projects for the benefit of young people in school locally for example: Olympic School Games events/festivals and some competitions/taster activities/ After-School Sports Clubs (Multi-Skills/Multi-Sports) for all pupils i.e. Active Lifestyle type clubs for physically inactive children and other targeted groups of pupils, including Talented children. As well as external grant funding to help set up: Community sports clubs and deploying paid sports coaches open to young people from across an area i.e. several schools, improved School Sports Facilities and sports equipment. It is likely that the majority of these externally funded projects, if successful, will be free of charge to all Primary Schools within the Partnership.**

- **We aim to provide a service that is good value for money. Please note this will be the first year we have had to organise/package and cost our services for schools (largely based on the wide variety of Primary questionnaire responses and priorities mentioned in Spring 2011 and Head Teacher/PLT requests at meetings). So this year, together with our presumed SSSCo capacity, will be a learning curve for us all, but we would welcome your feedback at all times to continually adapt and improve our services for Primary Schools, their staff and pupils.**
